Youth Engagement Program

The Youth Engagement Program is focused on the mental health and well-being of youth ages 6-18. This free program provides supportive services to youth as they navigate complex trauma, crisis, anxiety/depression, behavioral challenges, gang involvement, and other pressing needs. Our knowledgeable and experienced staff provides confidential individual and group counseling, as well as mentoring, to assist youth. Our goal is to help youth in Oak Park and River Forest live life in their greatest capacity and dismantle any barriers that may exist to help them.

This program is a collaboration of nine local government agencies from both communities that serve to provide a holistic approach to helping youth. They are able to receive individualized support to thrive in home, school, and the community. If you'd like to find out more about our program, call us at (708) 445-2727. Family Support

If you are a friend, family member or guardian concerned about a youth age 6-18, our staff is available to listen and give support to those seeking advice. We have access to a broad range of experienced professionals as well as local and regional agencies to help design an approach customized to each individual situation.

Youth and Family Services staff are committed to promoting positive opportunities for youth and families, and we advocate to enhance the social/emotional development of youth in the community. Our services include mental health wellness, parenting guidance, sibling support, improving family communication,

Girls on the Rise

Girls on the Rise is a unique and innovative program designed specifically for girls of color in grades 6-12. The goal of the program is to empower girls and provide them with tools to improve self-esteem, celebrate their cultural heritage, learn self-awareness and strengthen interpersonal relationships to prepare them for a successful transition to high school and adulthood. This program blends art, music, writing and other activities around a custom curriculum. We also host guest speakers and special workshops.

Girls on the Rise is available free to those attending Percy Julian Middle School, Gwendolyn Brooks Middle School, Roosevelt Middle School, or OPRF High School.

Hygiene Closet

Our Hygiene Closet was created to provide youth with essential personal care items, including soap, body wash, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, shaving cream, and menstrual products.

Prevention Services Programs

Communities struggling with sensitive issues such as substance and alcohol misuse, suicide, and/or violence can find support from Oak Park Township Prevention Programs. Our staff provides access to the tools, resources, support groups and service agencies that address these unique needs. To learn more, contact us at youth@oakparktownship.org.

The Prevention staff are also a part of the Workgroup for Positive Youth Development (+PYD coalition) which promotes health choices



through education, awareness of health issues, and community collaboration. Which has one goal to build health communities through level change from prevention to recovery.

Community Justice Program

The Community Justice Program works closely with the Villages' of Oak Park and River Forest's local adjudication divisions. We provide a Community Engagement program which works with youth to complete engagement hours at local organizations and businesses. We also provide specialized programming to youth and families around any issues that may have lead a youth to be referred to the adjudication process. We can provide restorative circles, peer mediations, and will offer group classes to youth and families as well.

Our Community Justice staff are all trained in Restorative Practices and are able to conduct circles and mediations not only at the adjudication level, but also to our other community partners, such as the school districts, libraries, and park districts around any issues that concern youth.

Financial Aid Scholarships

Our Financial Aid Scholarship program provides funds for Oak Park and River Forest youth to participate in extracurricular activities. Income guidelines, scholarship application and deadlines are available on our website. Oak Park youth ages 6 to 17 and River Forest youth ages 5 to 17 must apply for scholarship funds through the referring agency or organization. Community Outreach

Our Youth and Family Services reach out to residents in Oak Park and River Forest through community events, local businesses, and partner organizations.
